

The regular meeting of the Womens Institute for April was held at the home of Mrs Redmond on the afternoon of the 1st Inst. It being the 25th Anniversary of Mrs Redmonds wedding congratulations were tendered to our hostess. The meeting was opened by the Maple Leaf being sung. The minutes of the last meeting which was held on Jan. 8th were read and approved and signed by the President. The Secretary then read a letter from the ~~St Mary~~ Queen Mary Hospital for Consumptive Children asking for aid. It was agreed that one hundred dollars be donated to it for the upkeep of one cot for one year. The motion was not put or carried so it was left over until the next meeting. A letter was read from Mr Putnam offering garden seeds very cheaply. Several packages were ordered by members. The Secretary then read a petition for Prohibition but as some members were not in favor of it. It was dropped. The President then brought forward the business of the notes that were given last year in exchange for farm seeds by some of the needy farmers. As they were unable to meet the notes it was moved by Mrs James seconded by Mrs H. Morel that the notes be
