The regular monthly meeting of the Women's Institute was held at the home of Mrs J. P. Redmond on Thursday, June 8th, with the President, Mrs E. M. J. Bell occupying the chair.

The meeting was called to order with the reading of Institute creed and the singing of "O Canada". Minutes of previous meeting was read and approved, also Annual Financial Statement for the year ending 1938-39.
