May 2nd 1914 home of Mrs Chas. Fink fifteen members eight visitors - request from Muskoka Sanatorium for aid - (first request mentioned in minutes). Not decided on Election of officers followed remain the same except 1st vice Mrs Wm. Bangs. Plans finalized for a lecture June 1st from Agricultural office at no cost to Branch - contacted Andy Graham for use of town Hall.

June 1st 1914. Subject chosen for lectures were Home & School & an Ideal Home Secretary presented Mrs Smith & Daughter with farewell gifts: presentation in May, my error is due to a Bluke in the minutes. June 1st was not a regular meeting but lecture was held in Town Hall. by Mrs Susan Campbell of Toronto twenty - four Ladies were present she touched several topics & gave useful ideas regarding institute work. Her talk was so enjoyed the ladies invited her again the following year. Twelve members joined.

July 4th 1914 meeting home of Mrs Bangs, ten members a letter was read - from the Muskoka Home for Consumptive Children asking for aid - one dollar was sent - Mrs Bell held a tea July 9th to raise funds - arrangements were made for
