Aug 26th 1914 a special meeting at the home of
Mrs Bell to decide what our Institute could do to aid
in equipping a "Hospital Ship" for the "Imperial Navy".
It was decided as time was short ten dollars be sent.

Sept 2nd 1914, at home of Mrs Richardson, twenty-four
present. fourteen present. Calvin members were present, three
of them. three hundred silk flags were purchased
to be sold at Fall Fair. Plans to dig a well
in the fair grounds were completed. It was hoped
to have it ready for the fair since plans were
to have a supper at that time Sept 24th.

Sat. Sept. 26. 1914. a special meeting at the
home of Mrs Bell. purpose of planning some Red
Cross work. twenty five dollars was sent to the
Sec. of the Red Cross. Mrs Harry Mael & Miss Sandette
were named to arrange a concert at a near date the
proceeds in aid of Red Cross.
