Nov 4th 1914 held at Mrs John Bourkes home seventeen present. Report of sale of candies & bonus from moving picture show - \$18.34 This money was given to Relief Fund. for the Victims of the war in Belgium

Dec 1st 1914 - Mrs Frank Backer - fifteen members Receipts from the Belgium Consul was held consisted nine dollars was sent making a total of fifty. The first Delegates report was read.

Jan. 8th 1915 at the home of Miss Gaudette twenty seven present. five from Calvin. It was agreed Mrs Bengs should write a paper concerning Mattawa enlarging upon its natural Beauty and Desirabilities as a summer resort its water power and mining possibilities - the same to be sent to Red & Green & some newspapers within two weeks. A note was read from Mrs Bell suggesting members do some sewing for the soldiers, it met no response Mrs Hazelwood won a married women prize Miss Maxwell (must be Vera) won the single ladies prize.

Feb 3rd 1915 home of Mrs Ernest Fink, fourteen present. members decided to knit 25 or 30 pair of socks for soldiers from wool obtained from an address given to them.

March 3rd home of Mrs James Twenty present Wool has arrived for the socks.
