

April 7th 1915 at the home of Mrs Harry Muel twenty present. A circular was read; from the Centre & South Rifle Club, Toronto. asking us to sell Buttons for the purpose of raising funds for the Sock Fund. 100 buttons were ordered as well as a request for wool for another 18 or 20 pairs of socks

May 5th 1915 at the home of Mrs Le Neup sixteen present. much concern was shown for a Mrs Seconde Mrs Desormeaux. one can only suspect they were widowed mothers with sons at war. arrangements were made to hold a Euchre Party in the Harmony Hall to raise funds to endorse a cot in the Duchess of Connaughts hospital for wounded Canadian Soldiers.

A section of officers some group persuaded to keep office - thus President Mrs J. H. Bell. First Vice Mrs Bourke second vice Mrs Le Neup Secretary Treasurer. Mrs Hazelwood.

June 1st 1915. Town Hall an instructive lecture by Mrs. Mary Mac Kenzie. Smith of Gravenhurst Subj. what every woman ought to know and crossing the Bridges with our children. also a vivid description of the Muskoka Hospital for Tuberculosis.

July 7 Home of Mrs Muel (6) sixteen present Mrs Bell gave a report of a show given at her home in aid of Red Cross work. Receipts were received for fifty dollars from Red Cross & fifteen from Rifle Club. It was then agreed the W.I. members would take up work for the Red Cross Society and try and meet every two weeks at the home of some member to do sewing for them.
