(March 1916). April 4. 1916 home of Mrs. Valmore Fink twenty present.

May. 1916. Home of Miss Sandette. Twelve present - five dollars donated to local hospital. Report of shower of soldiers comforts at Mrs V. Fink. 18 parcels received. Election of officers - Mrs Bell has been president for four years - president now is Mrs Neal. other officers remain.

June 5 - 1916 home of Mrs James Twenty three present - Speaker Mrs. Morehouse on the eye and institute work.

July 5. 1916 Home of Mrs Le Keep nineteen

Aug 2 - 1916 held at the home of Mrs Bell. twenty - six present Mrs Blackburn (& M) a visitor

Sept. 6. 1916 Mrs Ches Fink. thirty three present. (15 given to Red Cross - \$10.00 towards ~~Saint~~ Childrens Cripple Hospital).

Oct 4. Nov saw regular meeting - ~~the~~ was held at Mrs Coopers twenty present. 15.00 given to Red Cross - \$10.00 towards Cripple Children Hospital

Dec 6th 1916 - regular Jan 2nd 1917 regular Feb - home of Mrs Bell. March 7 home of Mrs Ross forty to fifty seven from Calvin April 10th eleven present & it was agreed from now on to meet at Red Cross rooms. at this point the Branch seems on shaky ground - poor leadership or maybe it was war nerves, and this was the topic of each meeting
