 a girl under 16. 3rd + 2nd prizes in Lost Cases.

Oct 13th 1920 at the home of Mrs Summerhill
 twelve members. letter of thanks read from
 Queen Mary Hospital for \$6.00 proceeds of tag day
 Sept. 23rd Request - from Navy League for a
 Donation on tag Day. \$5.00 sent although some.
