be touched or drawn upon for any reason other
than a war memorial. Carried. A motion was passed
& carried the W. I. Funds be drawn upon for
Chataaugua work if necessary.

April 6th 1921 home of Mrs Newton. Arrangements
made for a Birthday tea April 20th at the home of
Mrs Freeman.

May 4th 1921 home of Mrs Dickson 20 present
Business omitted in favor of a social afternoon because
so many members were leaving town shortly. pictures
were taken on the lawn. (all members were requested
to move to lawn to be Kodaked)
