There are Anglicans Roman Catholics & United Church who
belong to it, we felt that had a Institute member got
the hall for a private party even if it was for a
organization and they looked after things they could
of had it, of course it never was used for this
as they have never had any parties unless to make
money, so this left only the young people in our
community getting it this way.
