1886 Reeve - Charles Vain

Councillors - Michael Pigeon, Jeremiah Labreque, Thomas
Burwash, Charles Brigdon.

Meetings called to order at 10:00 a.m. at Callander Station;
Ferdinand Brunet as Clerk and Assessor and Tax Collector,
Salary \$75.00 per year.

1895 Reeve F. Brunet

Councillors - M. Pigeon, A. Shields, Steven Dunn. M. R. Dunn
hired as Clerk, Salary \$50.00 and he was not Clerk again till
about 1905 as I have not got that book.

1896 - M. R. Dunn's offer to be Clerk at \$50.00 per year was
turned down and Louis Manseau was appointed Clerk, salary
\$60.00. Meetings were held at Nosbonsing.

1906 - The Town of Bonfield was incorporated and the size
is six hundred and fifty- five acres and had a population
of five hundred at the time.

The Township of Bonfield incorporated in 1887.

The next minute book I got is 1943 with J. A. Boivin Reeve
and Phillipe Boissonneault, James Savard, P. W. Pennell,
and Felix Chaput councillors.

1947 - Reeve Roland Larivierre, Councillors, Pennell, Chaput
Savard and Guillemette.

1954 - Reeve Roland Larivierre, councillors Guillemette,
Harry McLaren, Bedard, A. Boissonneault. M. R. Dunn, Clerk
and R. Riddell as assistant Clerk. July, R. Riddell
appointed Clerk.
