

Minutes of the Third Monthly meeting of Sarard  
Women's Institute held in the Community Hall,  
Friday July 13, 1928

Meeting opened at 3.30 p.m. Mrs. Pummell presiding  
Attendance was fifteen.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and adopted.  
The committee in charge of the work done on the  
School grounds reported the driveway made by the  
School Board free but the Institute was to furnish  
the gates.

The members discussed the letter from Miss Smith  
P. N. N. in which she asked help for a child in the  
school, needing glasses. Moved by Mrs. Pummell,  
seconded by Mrs. Neal that the Institute pay for  
glasses. Carried.

It was suggested by Mrs L. Moussey that the

as advised by Miss Alexander, the nurse who  
conducted a two weeks class in nursing. It was  
decided to have first Mrs. Pummell interview  
the School Board to see what was needed most.
