The Minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

The Financial Statement showed a bank balance of \$42.11 and cash on hand of \$44.90.

Correspondence was read.

Secretary gave a report of the clothing drive and also reported on the Tuberculosis clinic to be held in Charlton on September 16, 3-9 p.m.

A further report was given by the Scholarship committee. Some discussion followed. It was decided that Floyd James' application would be accepted (His guardian is paying tuition or the equivalent.)
