

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

The annual Meeting of the Women's Institute of Ferris Karning Centre District was held in the Heaslip Hall on Tuesday June 13, 1950 with Mrs. Merle Brownlee, the district President in the chair.

The meeting was called to order at 1:15 p.m. by the singing of O. Canada - Mrs. Dorothy Houston was at the piano.
