Mrs. J. Clement, Board Director (alternate for Mrs. L. Humphries who had been ill) reported for the G. W. I. O. Board of Directors. She extended best wishes on behalf of Mrs. Humphries and greetings from the Provincial President and Board. In her report, Mrs. Clement told of the Ontario display of Handicrafts that would be taken to the A.C. W. W. Conference in Australia; of the support given to the International Scholarship Fund, reminding Institutes again to reduce free giving in favour of needs of our own organization; that the G. W. I. O. Board was considering re-investing Scholarship Funds in a common fund so that a greater rate of interest could be realized; that the southern bus tour had been cancelled due to lack of applicants; that safety measures this year will be on "Electrical Safety"; that there will be a special Forum Forum program on "Leisure Time" in winter 1963, in which I. I. will again participate; that the Institute cup and saucer will soon be available; that the Board had decided to send a representative to attend A.C. W. W. Council meetings in London in the person of the Provincial President; that 2 new county scholarships had been set up; that 2 resolutions submitted in 1961 from this area had been lost.
