"More About Giniches" is the project chosen for the Senior Training School this year and Institutes were urged to have a better representation this year, so that the project would reach more women and be more successful.

Several displays were exhibited by the branches and these were commented on by members from each branch. These included Friendship Quilts, An old quilt made in 1867, Blouses made by 4-H Club members, Articles from Mexico, dolls of other lands and "Pen Pals Through A.C.W.W."

Following comments, the meeting adjourned. Dinner was served by Grand Women's Institute.

During the noon hour, an Auction Sale was held with Mrs. George Bott as auctioneer. Proceeds amounted to 19.72 for District Funds.
