

Those reports from Branches you mention were made in 1949 or 1950
F.W.D. asked for these when working on "50 years of Achievement" (you have a
copy?) and should give you some records for each branch and where a
branch can provide no further use a copy of them for a beginning of a branch
history (a very meager report is all I have on one of our branches.) It might be
interesting to know dates of earlier (D.A.'s) or (Conventions) if Melberta Curator
found any of these. (1908 to 1916) (1927 to 1933)

while compiling their branch history. I've written to Toronto to
see if any Convention information can be found - but that goes back so far
to look through all their reports! If anything is found I promised to relay
to all other curators.

Rockley 1916-17-18-19 belonged down this end of District I
think but I can't find any such place on my old map. Could it be that they
disbanded and then re-organized in 1929. You have written Rock where I have

I turned over the books I obtained my information from to Mrs
Goddard - Minute Books 1916 to 1920 and 1920 to 24 (Mrs Young, Cochrane
has 1924 to 1927 and gave us notes on same) I sent her 1927 to 1930 which
was definitely a Cochrane District Minute Book and also a District Membership
Book of same years. District Membership Book for 1916 to 1919 went to Mrs
Goddard - I obtained all information from these books. Notice these are all
District Books - no branches except one of Buckle Sept 1909-14 no information
there re D.A.'s or else I overlooked same - Hold on - was it this book which
mentioned that "branches up North" were invited to attend 1911 D.A.? Noticed
that somewhere on I lived "up North". Re Hillview my notes show
1916 to 1923 - these were places where I couldn't tell whether a branch had
over
