

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Date June 12th 1935 Place Baptist C^h New Liskeard

Registration of delegate and member taken by Mr. Beckett at 9.30 a.m.

Community singing with Mrs. Fowler accompanying till 10 a.m. when the meeting was opened by the President Mr. H. Raymond in the Chair, the opening Institute Ode was sung and the Lord's prayer repeated.

The roll call of delegate was then taken and the delegate took their appointed places, all Branches but one being represented.

The minutes of the last Annual meeting was read by the secretary, which were adopted on the motion of Secretary seconded by Mrs. Bayford (Mrs. Cook) Carried.

Address by the President was then listened to, in a few pleasant words she expressed the pleasure of seeing so many old faces, and also some new ones, and felt we had made good progress in the past year, two new Branches being organized during the year, 'Baileighurst Link White Junction and 'Blanche River' at Gillhampton, making seven Branches in the District.

The Financial report was then presented by the Secretary showing an income of 131.¹⁶ with an Expenditure of 130.⁵⁵ leaving a small balance of 5s. in the treasury.

Auditors report was then given by Mr. A. R. Baker and accepted.

The next item of business was the reports of Commissions of standing Committees.

Mr. G. A. K. Hughes on Agriculture gave an account of Rotherly, Whitwood Green and Willburt.
