

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Date June 12 1935 Place Baptist Ch. New Liskeard

The twenty members that compose the Board, have a very busy time, then seven thirty resolutions brought up and nineteen passed at the meeting.
 One resolution that was passed was that no officer in District or Branch should hold office for longer than six consecutive years, the address was quite interesting and enlightening.
 The secretary then read the minutes of the Dis. Director.

2 Resolutions were then read from the Darbury Branch as follows.
Resolved that we petition the Government for a reduction of tax to any point in Ontario, for people of limited means, who find it necessary to go for an operation which cannot be performed in their own District, and to include T. D. Patients, Wabes Valley had a resolution on similar lines. Carried.

Another from the Darbury Branch as follows.
Resolved that we urge the Government to see that a safety pass is made along highways for the protection of children and pedestrians. Carried.

The first resolution brought out some discussion and Miss Collins suggested that we try to get the co-operation of the Medical Association in the matter.

It was proposed by Mr. Grant, seconded by Mr. Boyford that we pass ^{that} resolution on to the Convention. Carried

Proposed by Mr. Belton, seconded by Mr. W. B. Johnson that the resolution on "Highways" be passed on to Convention. Carried

Miss Collins address which touched on many phases of Institute work was most thoroughly enjoyed.
 Mr. Raymond spoke on the last hour and suggested that we get the room at the Post Office, that is vacant if arrangements can be made regarding the cost of same.
