

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Relief - Mr. E. Routhiffe - Danbury

It was moved by Mr. Ross seconded by Mr. J. D. Cragg that the Secretaries salary be 25 dollars

Mr. Plaut agreed to this for one year. Carried.

Three resolutions were then read, two that were passed last year from Danbury & Water Valley, and one on similar lines from New Liskeard, moved by Mr. Plaut seconded by Mr. J. Massie that they all be passed on to the Convention. Carried.

Resolution No 1.

A resolution was passed by the Danbury Branch, that we ask the Government to see that a safety path is made along highways for the protection of children & pedestrians.

Resolution No 2.

Resolved that we petition the Government for a reduced fare, to any point in Ontario, to people of limited means who find it necessary to go away for an operation, which cannot be performed in their own District, to include T. B. patients - Danbury & Water Valley resolution.

Resolution No 3.

Whereas the Districts from Cochrane South have an special Railway rate for emergency and other cases, having to attend a Toronto Hospital for treatment; such cases very often being delayed for the one cent a mile fare and in many cases proving fatal.

Therefore be it resolved - That we, the Women Institute of said Districts petition the Ontario Government, asking that such persons having a written statement from their advising City Hospital treatment, be granted the one cent a mile rate at any time. Moved by Mr. Massie, 2nd by Mr. Ross.

That we give a vote of thanks to the musicians & Danbury ladies. Mr. Scumler made a vote of thanks to Miss Collier & Mrs. McCall. Carried.
