P.R.O report - Mrs. W. Ross had 11 reports showed a money value raised of \$ 2278.94 plus many charitable donations of hand work etc. making a good District report. This report was accepted on motion of Ross & Waugh cd

Evaluation - Mrs. Clement was indeed pleased with the reports altho 100% had not been achieved. She said many ideas were new to her and she felt they showed great imagination and good planning. She especially made mention of the good roll calls and mottoes as reported.

Mrs. Clement gave the I.W.O. report for Mrs. Humphreys. She brought greetings from Mrs. Lynturner the President \$132,637.57 had been given from W.O.s to other organizations. The National Scholarship is given out of general funds at an average of \$2.00 per member but from the individual, herself. There is a Re. Investment Scholarship Fund in which are old bonds which are of no use to anyone as they are. There were 14,400 Sr Institutes with 36,993 members. also 33 Jr Institutes with 740 members. At time of reporting there were 2679 Life members. - out of these 32 were new ones in 1961. There were 264 children adopted. 568 branches gave \$1886.00 to Adelaide Handless Fund. 88 branches & districts gave \$1045.94 to Pennie for Friendship
