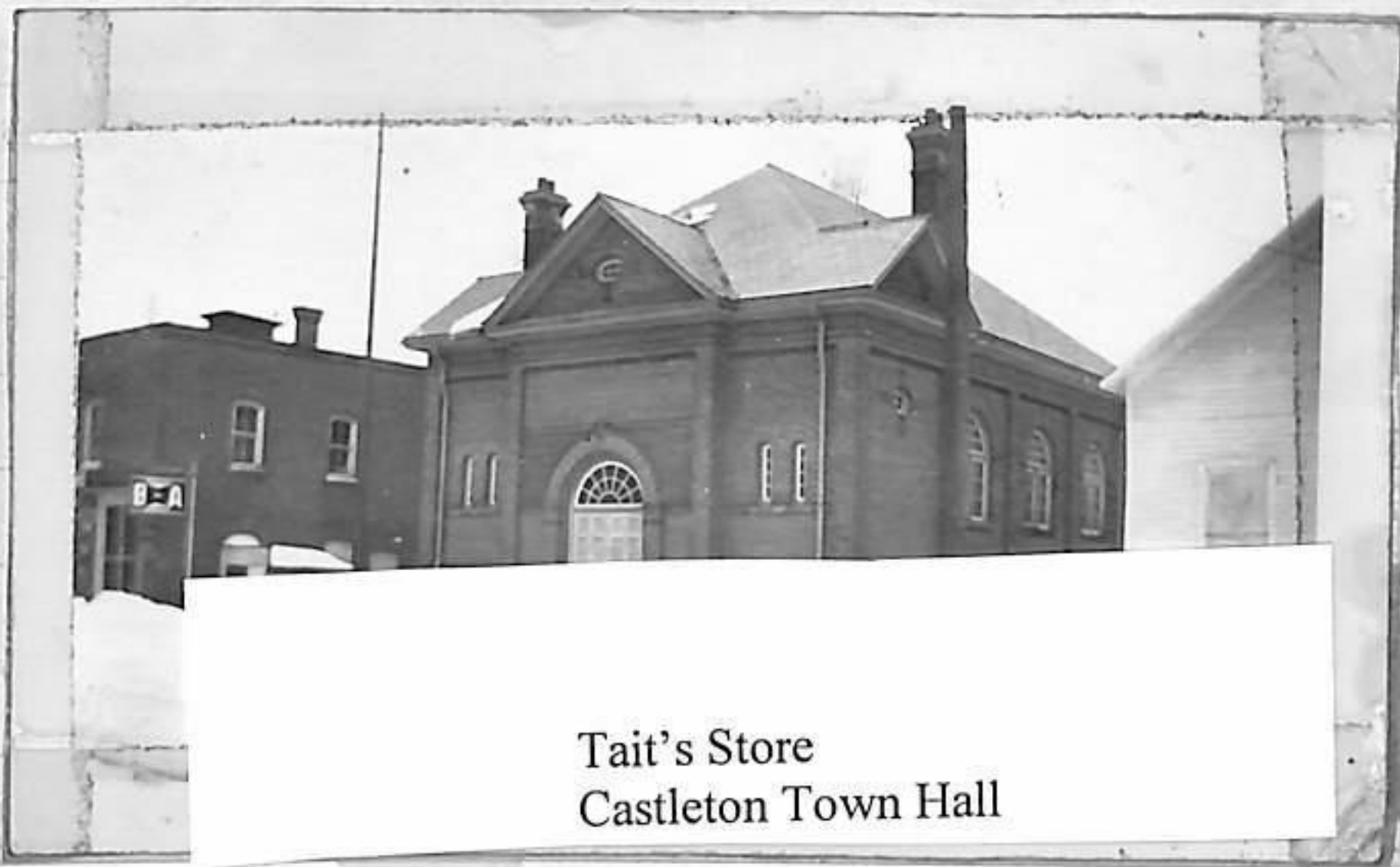


to have some type of communication with the outer world and that was a stage running from Warkworth to Colborne by way of the Mount Pleasant road. over the Canal bridge, passed Clark over Pegman's hill and to Castleton. A hotel and a stage office ^{were} was in Castleton, and the stage carried on to Colborne which later on would be on a condouroy road (see page. 32).

Since Castleton was the municipal seat of the township, the first councils were met in the building which is now Harry Moore's store. After this building was sold it met in the post office until a town hall was erected in 1893 by a contractor named Crowe from Trenton at \$4,500.00.
