The purpose of the evening, held at the Embro Community Centre, was to inspire women living in the Oxford County area to live a rich and rewarding life and to raise funds for the Oxford District WI Scholarship.



Award-winning actor, Seana McKenna, a 25-year veteran with the Stratford Shakespeare Festival, gave an insider's look into her life on stage – a storyline that has played out in front of live audiences all across North America. One theme of her presentation was the importance of growing up in the country and how it played a vital role in the development of her family, her husband's family and in the raising of their son.

Before announcing the two 2016 scholarship winners, all former recipients present were recognized with a loud round of applause, including Joan MacDermid (nee Otto) who was the very first recipient in 1953.
