## ALLENFORD GETS SCHOOL ADDITION

Two Rooms Being Added to  
Present School at Cost  
of \$6,500

Excellent progress is being made in the construction of the new two-room addition to the Allenford Public School, which is expected to be ready for occupancy when the schools re-open on the first of September. The work of construction was begun about two weeks ago, the contractors, Messrs. Hector Diebel and J. Miller, put a large gang of men on the work, with the result that the foundation and excavation have been completed and the brick work was started on Friday.

The new addition, which is being built on the east side of the present school building, and which is estimated to cost about \$6,500, exclusive of equipment, will be of brick, and will be substantial in every way. When completed it will provide adequate accommodation for the two rooms of the Continuation School, which has been held for some time past in the Orange Hall. The citizens of Allenford and vicinity are quite delighted to think that after a long wait they are at last to have suitable school accommodatio.
