- Nov. 16, 1932 - Organization of Institute. Decided the time of the meeting should be the second Thursday of every month.
- Dec. 9, 1932 - Changed name from #3 Highway West to Atherton Women's Institute.
- Jan. 12, 1933 - Three day course to be taken on Nutrition.
- Jan. 12, 1933 - Dr. R. B. Hare, Simcoe, talked on "Influenza".
- Mar. 9, 1933 - St. Patrick's Day party at Mrs. J. Whiteheads, (40) members and husbands
- May 17, 1933 - Joint meeting with Oakcrest & Lynedoch.
- June 8, 1933 - Spoke of North & South District being divided each with their own D.A.
- July 13, 1933 - Entertained by a gentleman friend at his home Mr. Wright.
- Aug 10, 1933 - Program by Junior Girls.
- Aug. 10, 1933 - Speaker - Miss G. Culver, she told of her experiences in teaching in north.
- Nov. 30, 1933 - Family, Hallowe'en Party at home of Mrs. F. Cole.
- Mar. 16, 1934 - St. Patrick's Party - husbands in charge of the program.
- May. 18, 1934 - Decided to send cards to sick or bereaved instead of flowers.
- May 18, 1934 - \$3.50, donated for playground equipment for Sand Valley School.
- June 14, 1934 - Moved there be no meetings in July & Aug. (this was decided yearly)
- Nov. 8, 1934 - Entertained Courtland Institute.
- Dec. 13, 1934 - Sale of tickets on quilt \$14.80, made by the branch, won by Mrs. Mary Bacon.
- Jan. 25, 1935 - Community Night with 30 present at Mrs. F. Andrews home.
- Feb. 14, 1935 - Exchanged seeds and plants.
- Mar. 14, 1935 - Received thanks for quilting six quilts for Childrens Shelter.
- Dec. 10, 1935 - Canned Fruit collected for Norfolk General Hospital.
- Feb. 13, 1936 - Cancelled meeting because of snow, also cancelled the meeting the next week.
- Apr. 9, 1936 - Ordered trees to be planted at S. S. No. 7.
- June 11, 1936 - Lynville Branch entertained Atherton.
Mrs. H. Y. Culver attended Triennial Conference at Guelph.
- Oct. 13, 1936 - Held party to raise money for Crippled children - \$2.55 netted.
- Nov. 12, 1936 - Institute offered to help pay for having children of Sand Valley vaccinated against dyptheria.
- Apr. 8, 1937 - Eleanor Pullen (Gedye) played piano solos.
- May 13, 1937 - Mrs. Wilson leader of Junior Activities told of course "Cotton is Smart".
- Jan. 12, 1939 - Planned Box Social to be held at Bethel School - raised \$17.25.
- Apr. 13, 1939 - Sent Dorothy Colley as delegate to Girl's Conference at Guelph.
- Feb. 1940 - Mrs. Geo. M. Boughner read poem "The Bethel Mutual Improvement Society".
- May. 1940 - Applied for short Course "Vegetable Cookery".
