In the year 1926 the band first entered in competition at the Toronto Exhibition and have been competing nearly every year since. They have won a number of prizes as well as the C. G. Conn Trophy in 1935. This year of 1960 under the leadership of Mr. A. Delane, the band won second place, just two points behind the first place band.
