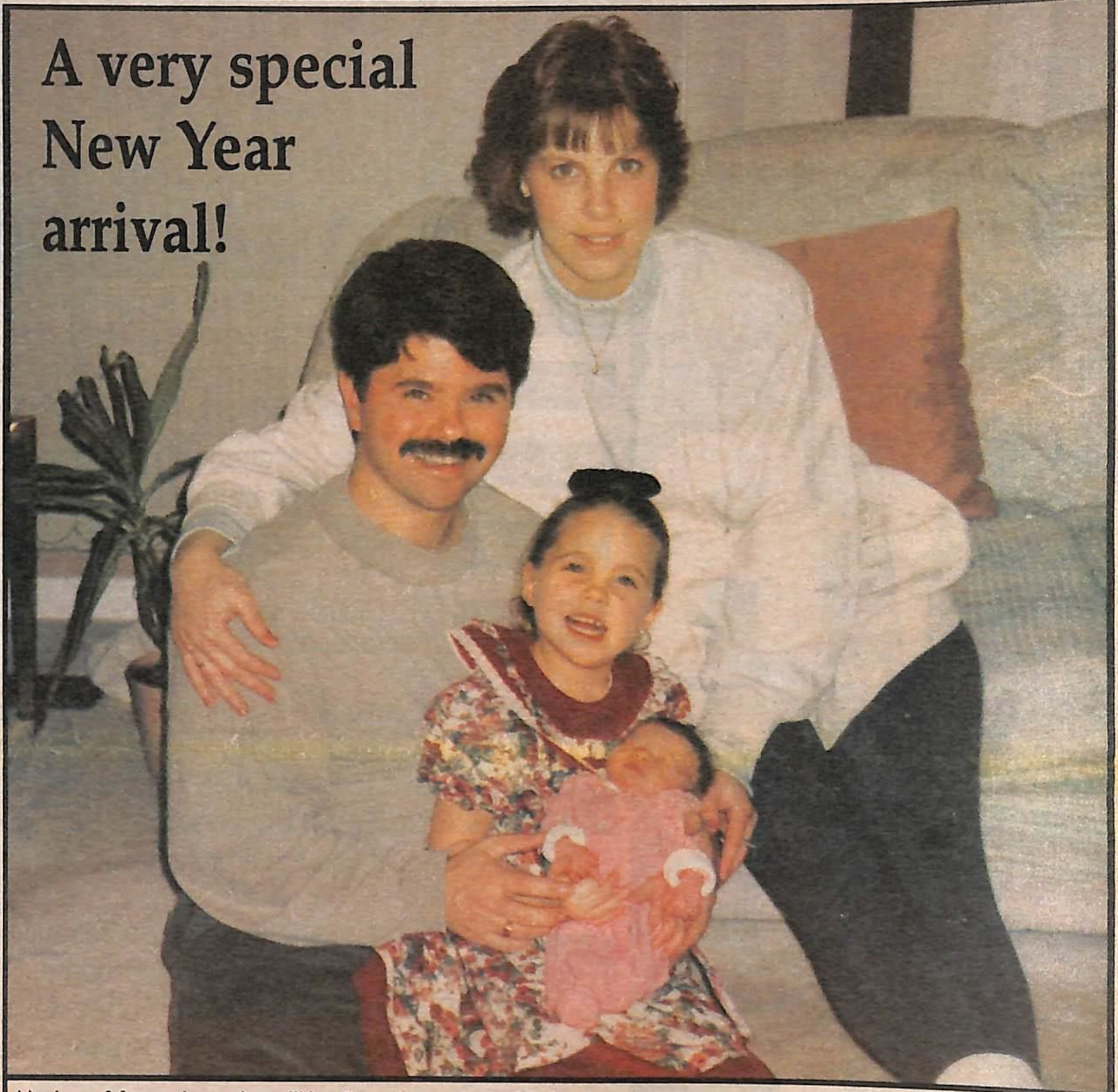

## Grimsby's historic Temple Building burns

"We owe an incredible debt to Grimsby firefighters", said Union Lodge No. 7 past Master and historian Bob Brooks. "We thought we'd lost everything, and the loss of history in that building is not just a loss for Masonry, but for Grimsby."

The Temple Building at 35

Main Street West which housed the Masonic Lodge, Home Hardware and Heida's suffered heavy damage on Wednesday, but some of the Lodge's historic records and memorabilia were saved.

The fire, which broke out accidentally during roof repairs, destroyed the Lodge room and

meeting room on the second floor of the building, but firefighters worked to keep the flames from the Museum at the front of the structure.

Brooks aid the original charter was not in the Lodge at the time of the fire, nor were the original minutes from 1904.
