Mrs. George Scott was also a member of the first Tweedsmuir History Committee giving help and guidance in the starting and early compiling of the history.

Mrs. Scott joined the Belfountain-Rockside Branch in 1921 and acted as President in 1926 - 1928. She continued as an active member and was made a Branch Life Member in April 1958.

After the death of her husband and the sale of the farm in 1956, she moved to Erin but continued her membership with the Belfountain-Rockside Branch.

With the re-organization of the Erin Branch, Mrs. Scott transferred her Life Membership there, thus yet another valuable member was lost.

Mrs. John Trimble became the second Curator for the Tweedsmuir History Book. She joined the Belfountain-Rockside Branch in 1942 and during the intervening years served as-- Secretary-Treasurer 1946-1949; President 1953-1956; President of North Peel District 1959-1961; Convener of Agriculture and Canadian Industries in the Central Convention Area 1961-1964; Board Director of the Federated Women's Institutes of Ontario 1964-1967.

In April 1958 she was made a Branch Life Member and in 1961 a Life Member of Peel North District. In 1971 she again became the History Curator. She filled this office until April 77 at which time Mrs. Wm. Laughlin was elected curator for one year. Mrs. Trimble resumed the duties of curator April 1978-80 and completion of compilation of 75 years of Institute History.
