Mrs. Adelaide Hoodless: born Adelaide Hunter on February 27, 1857 on a farm near St. George in Brant County, Ontario, daughter of John Hamilton Hunter, farmer.

In 1881, she married John Hoodless of Hamilton, Ontario. They had one son and two daughters.

The Homestead was made an Historic Site at an unveiling ceremony on June 13, 1959.

Mrs. Adelaide Hunter Hoodless was cited as a National Figure at an impressive unveiling of a plaque in her honour at the Homestead on June 2, 1962, by the National Historic Site Board.
