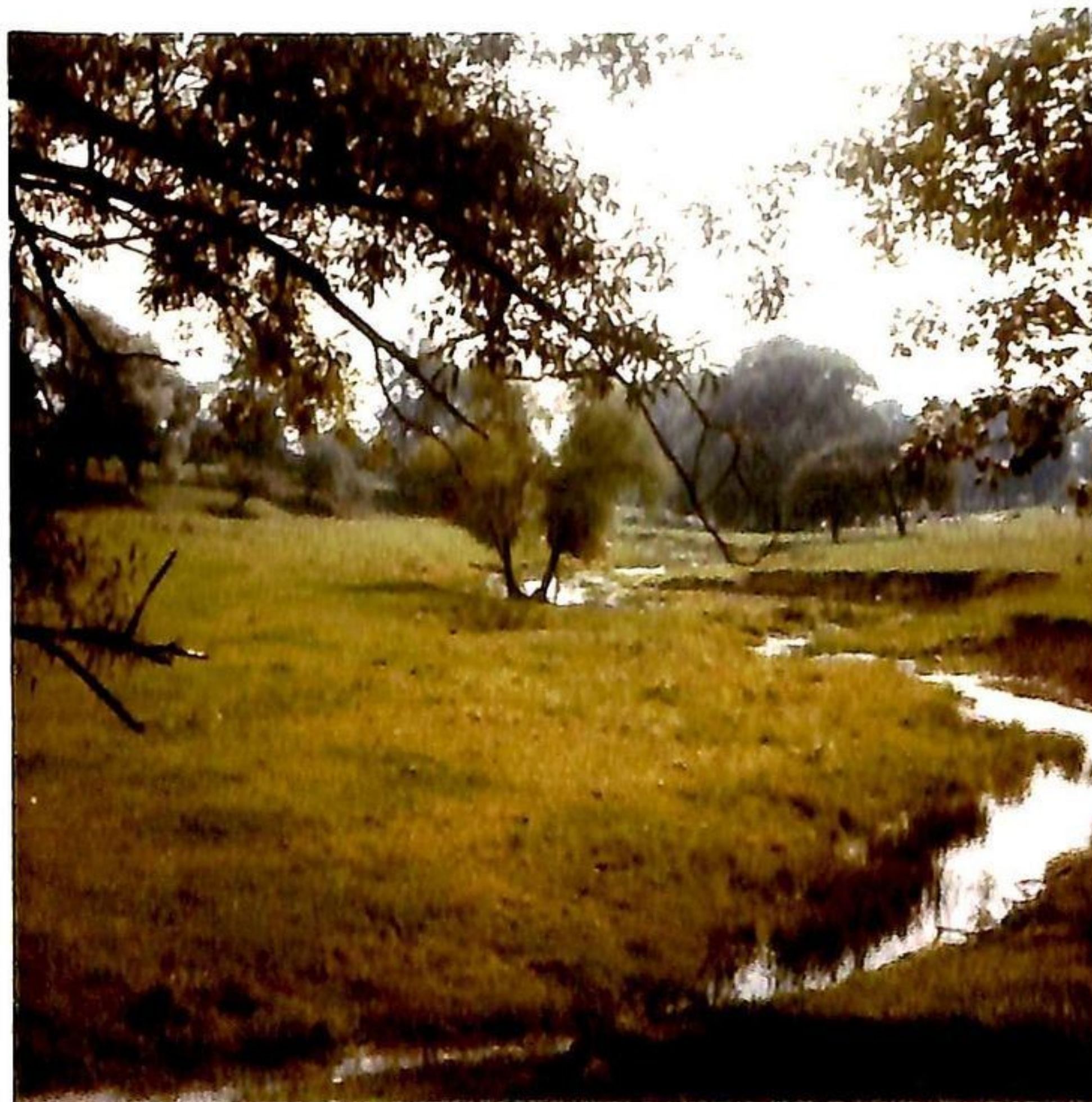
The worth of these records can only be evaluated by the interest shown in them and the information gained from them.
