

PROJECTS OF BIRR WOMEN'S INSTITUTE

In 1922, as a means of raising funds "for the beautifying of our village cemeteries and social welfare of our rural community" a cook book containing recipes of Birr Women's Institute members was compiled. The contributing members' name appears at the conclusion of each recipe. The recipe books sold for \$.50 each and were printed with a durable hard cover. In recent years a copy was returned to the Birr Women's Institute and has been placed in the Middlesex County Library, Arva, Ontario.
