



# Heritage site of week *July 17/18*

Unlike other bridges, the Bloomsburg Bridge is a perfect shaped Roman stone archway that is situated at its original location. It serves Bloomsburg residents as a pedestrian footbridge over the creek, providing a safe alternative to the highway. Nanticoke Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee recognizes it as historically important as it is a reminder of the days when Regional Road 24 was the main transportation route between Sikee and Waterford.
