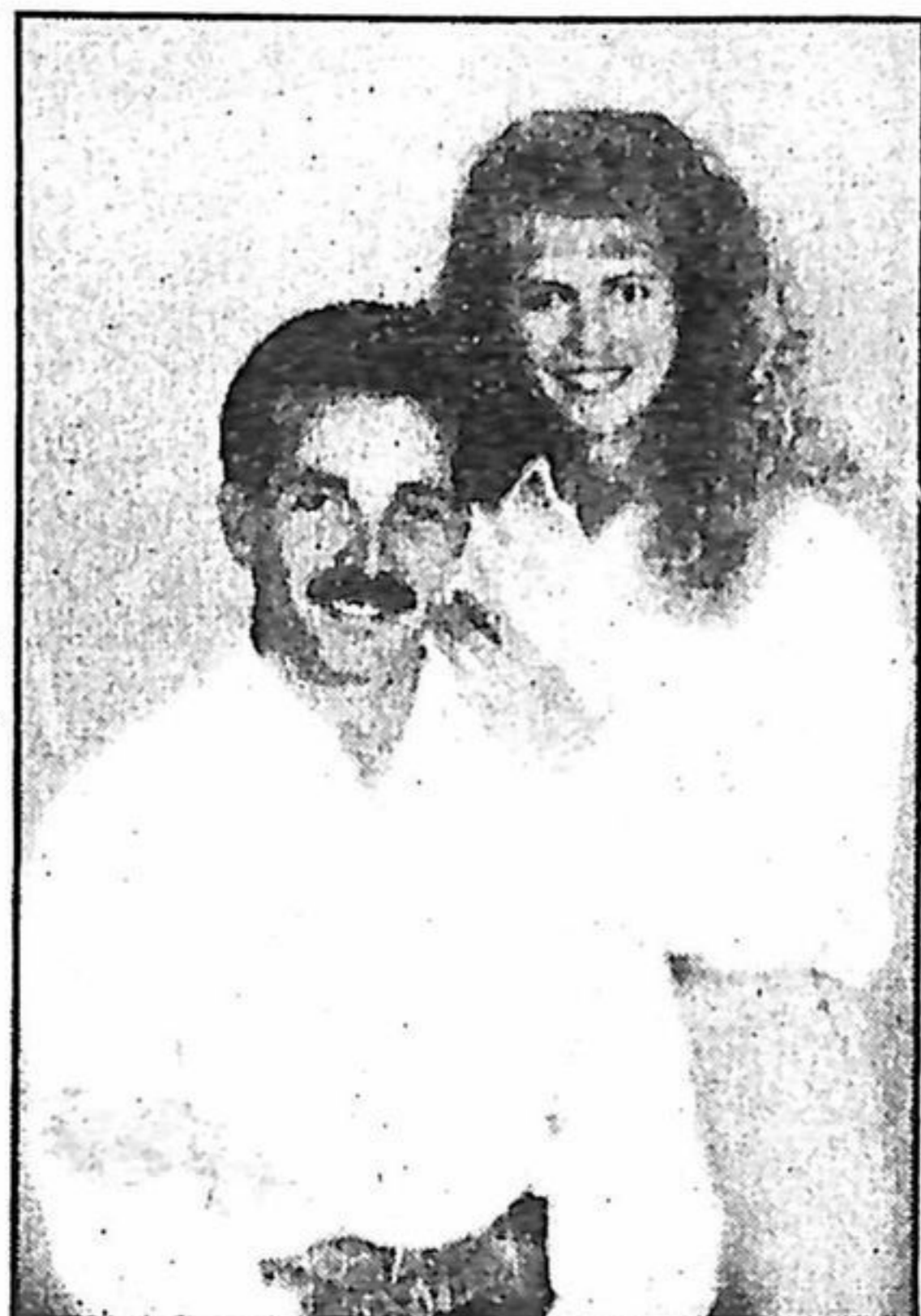




Another day at the market

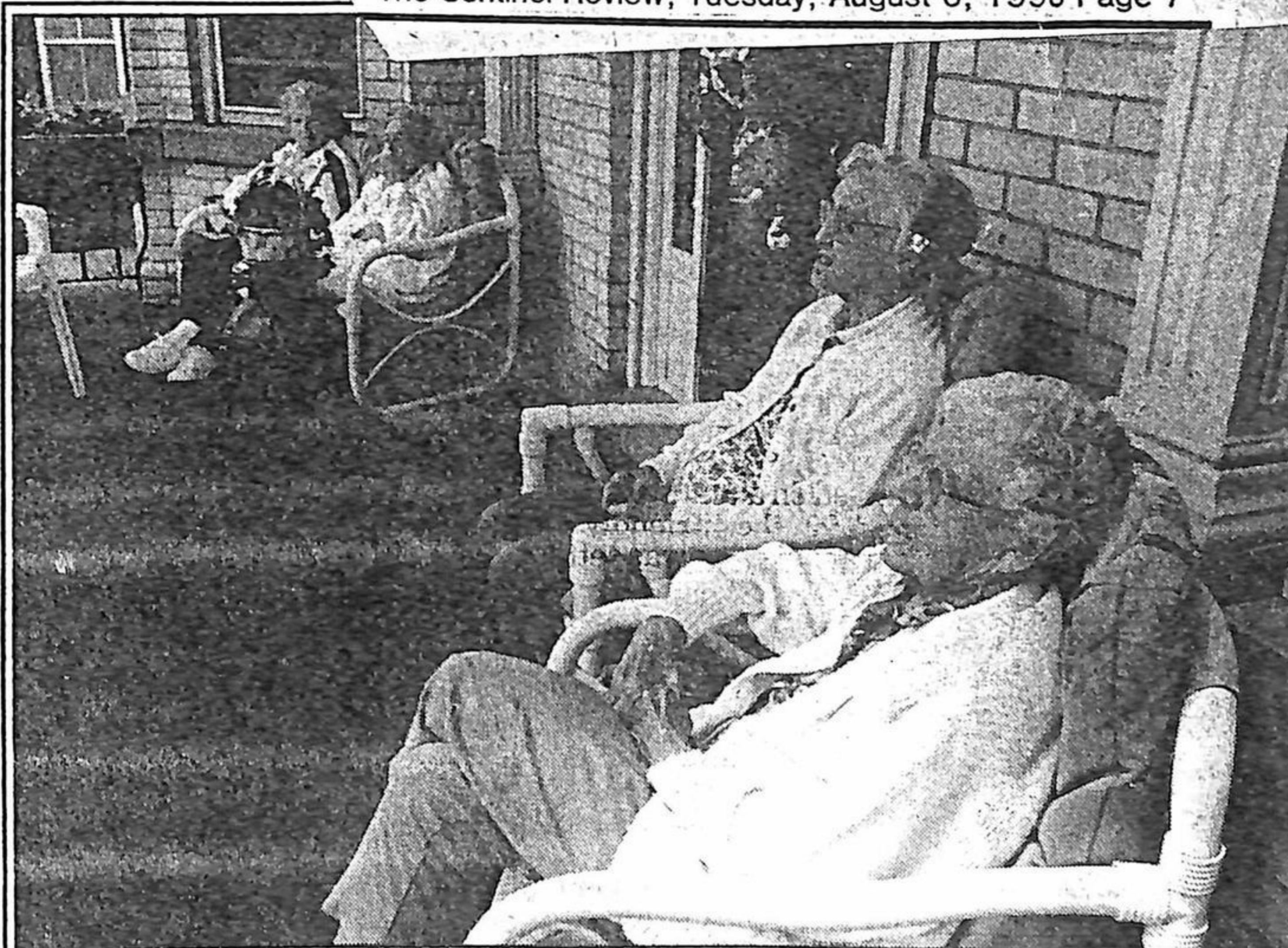
