

## Browns Corners Cater To WI Convention

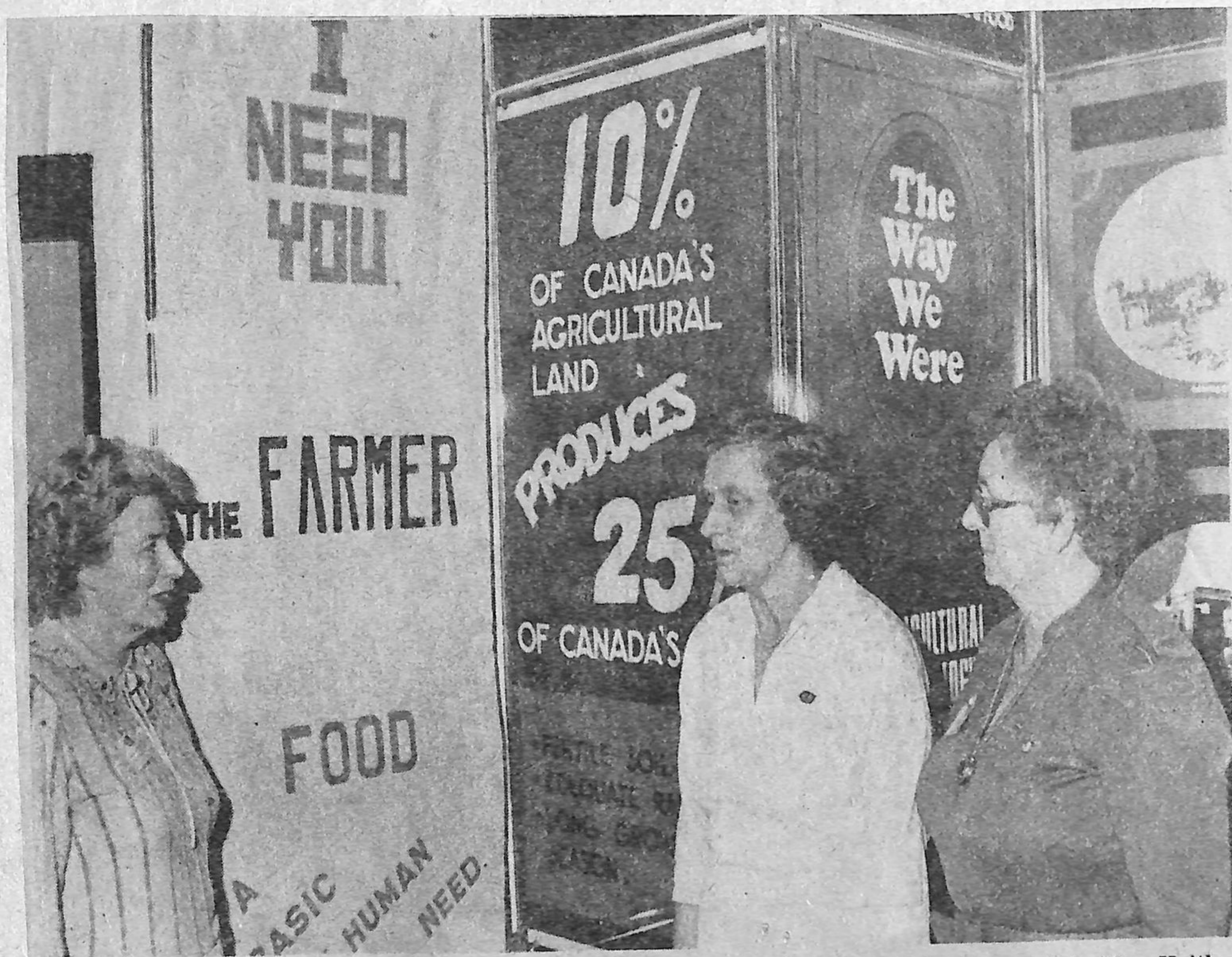
