The members brought gifts for draws, so many people went home with a small token.

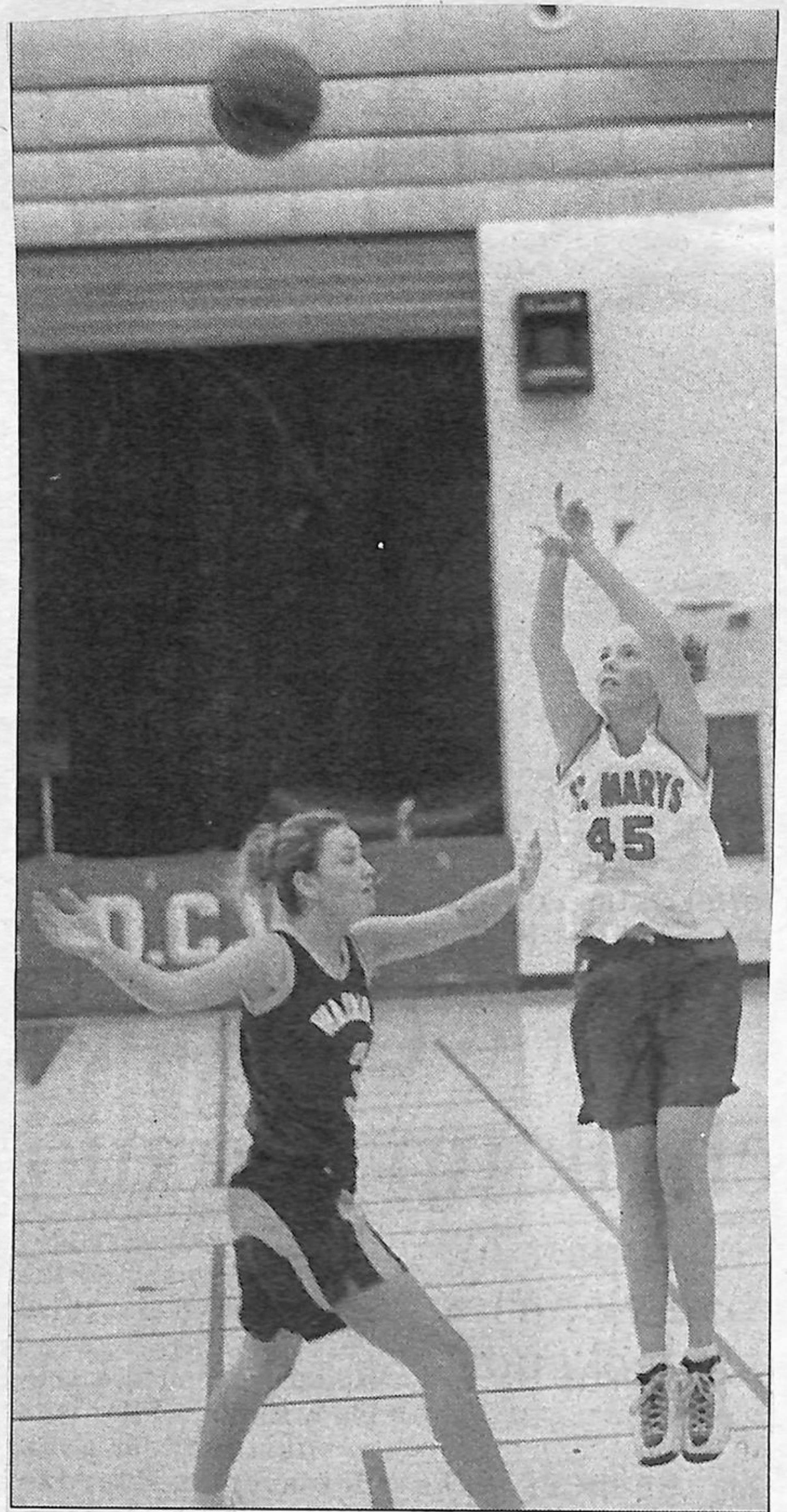
The Institute would like to thank everyone for coming and supporting them.
