Brown's W.I. held a euchre last Thursday night with nine tables. Mrs. W. Vanstreaan and her group were in charge of supplying the prizes.

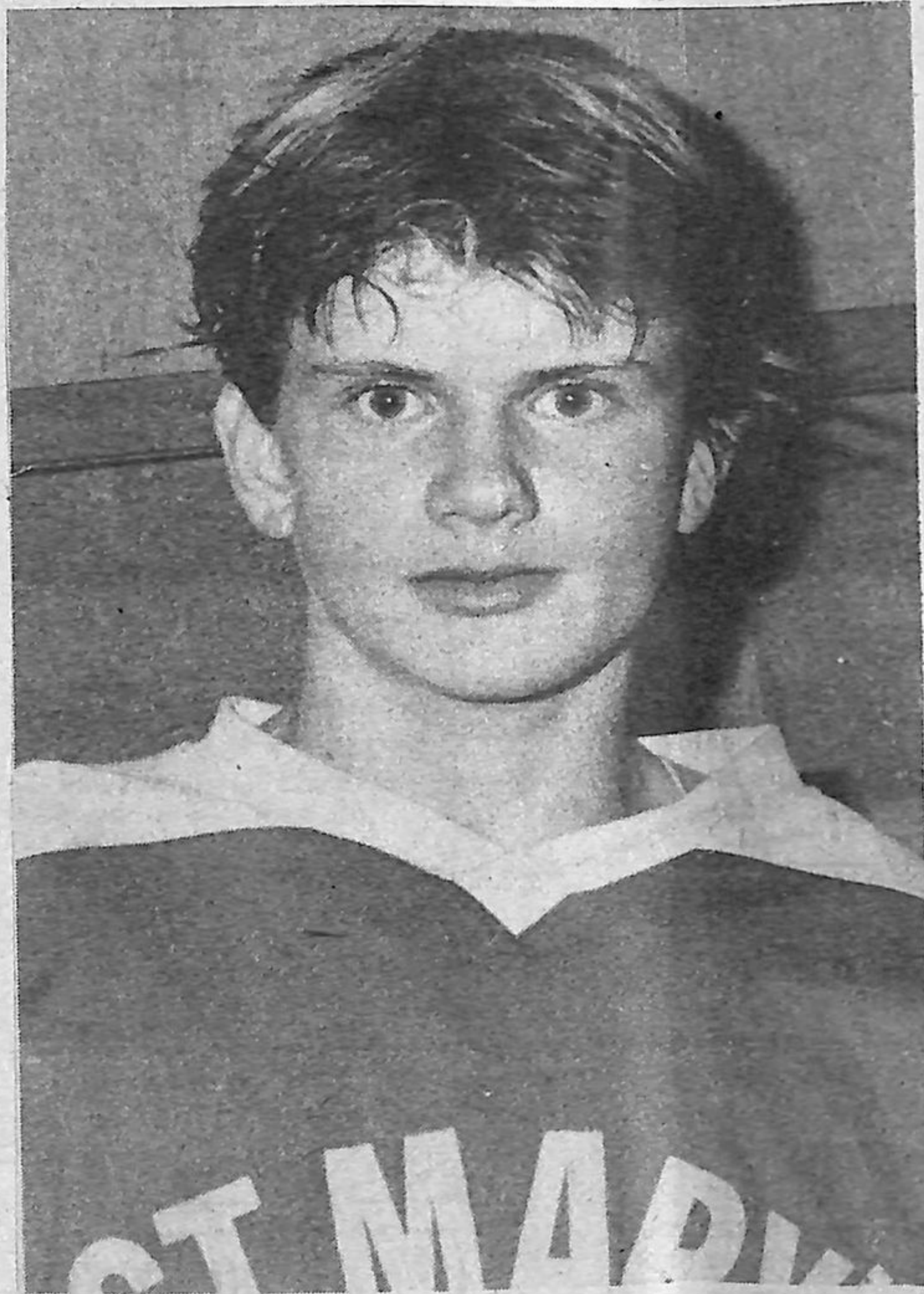
Prize winners were high Betty Johnson and Bill Switzer, lone hands Ina
