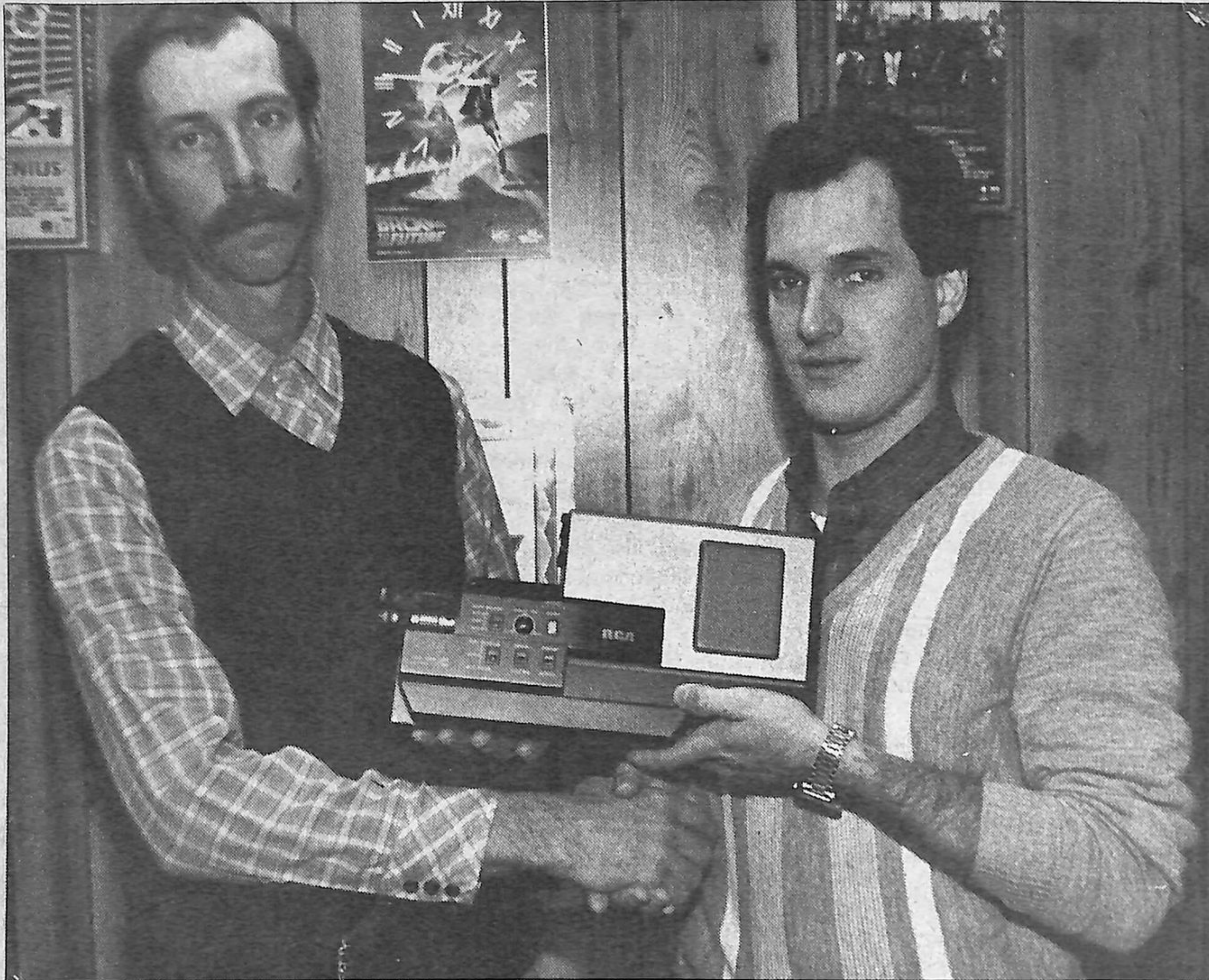


## Lincs early bird gets camera
