March 28, 1940 - Mrs. Sinkins was guest speaker taking as her subject, Charity and Relief.

June 27, 1940 - Mrs. Lou Davis of Stellburn, gave a very interesting talk on Education. He often got Mrs. Davis to speak when we were guests of other N. D.'s.

August 24, 1940 - Dr. Stiddis, Lakeside gave a very interesting address on the difference between contagious and infectious diseases.

October 24, 1940 - Mrs. K. B. Clysdale gave an address on Legislation.

November 25, 1940 - Mr. Tuck of Spruceleigh Poultry farm showed "moving pictures" of the visit of Their Majesties King George and Queen Elizabeth to Canada and United States. He also showed pictures of Spruceleigh poultry farm.
