workmanship of its designer and builder, Mr. E A Moore of Otterville who transformed rugged field stone boulders of our vicinity into such a pyramid of beauty. Upon the arch in raised numerals re "1914-1918" and underneath are the signifigant words -"Truth-Duty-Valour." a testimony a to service well and truly rendered as well as a worth-while ideal for youths to follow in a time when the peace of the world is so much desired. On either side of the archway proper a tier of stone pillars continues (interested with two ties of iron tubing) to each end of the grounds, where gate entrances are provided, the pillars of which are capped with oval glass globes bearing the inscription "Brownsville Community Park",

Such is a brief resume of present day activities of Brownsville community and events in connection therewith, written not in a boastful spitirt of pride, but with the two-fold purpose of creating a public spirit to commemorate the memory of our soldier boys and fallen heros, and also to stimulate greater interest in our community centres and rural schools and their surroundings that they may abound with culture and reserve become the beauty spots of every neighborhood.
