Upon the arch in raised numerals are "1914-1918" and underneath are the significant words -"Truth-Duty-Valour." a testimony to service well and truly rendered as well as a worth-while ideal for youths to follow in a time when the peace of the world is so much desired. On either side of the archway proper a tier of stone pillars continues (interconnected with two tiers of iron tubing) to each end of the grounds, where ~~the~~ gate entrances ^{are} ~~is~~ provided, the pillars of which are capped with oval glass globes bearing the inscription "Brownsville Community Park", a
