Bill Baxter, Agriculture Representative from Oxford County, introduced the speaker, Garnet Norrich, from the Agricultural College of Guelph.

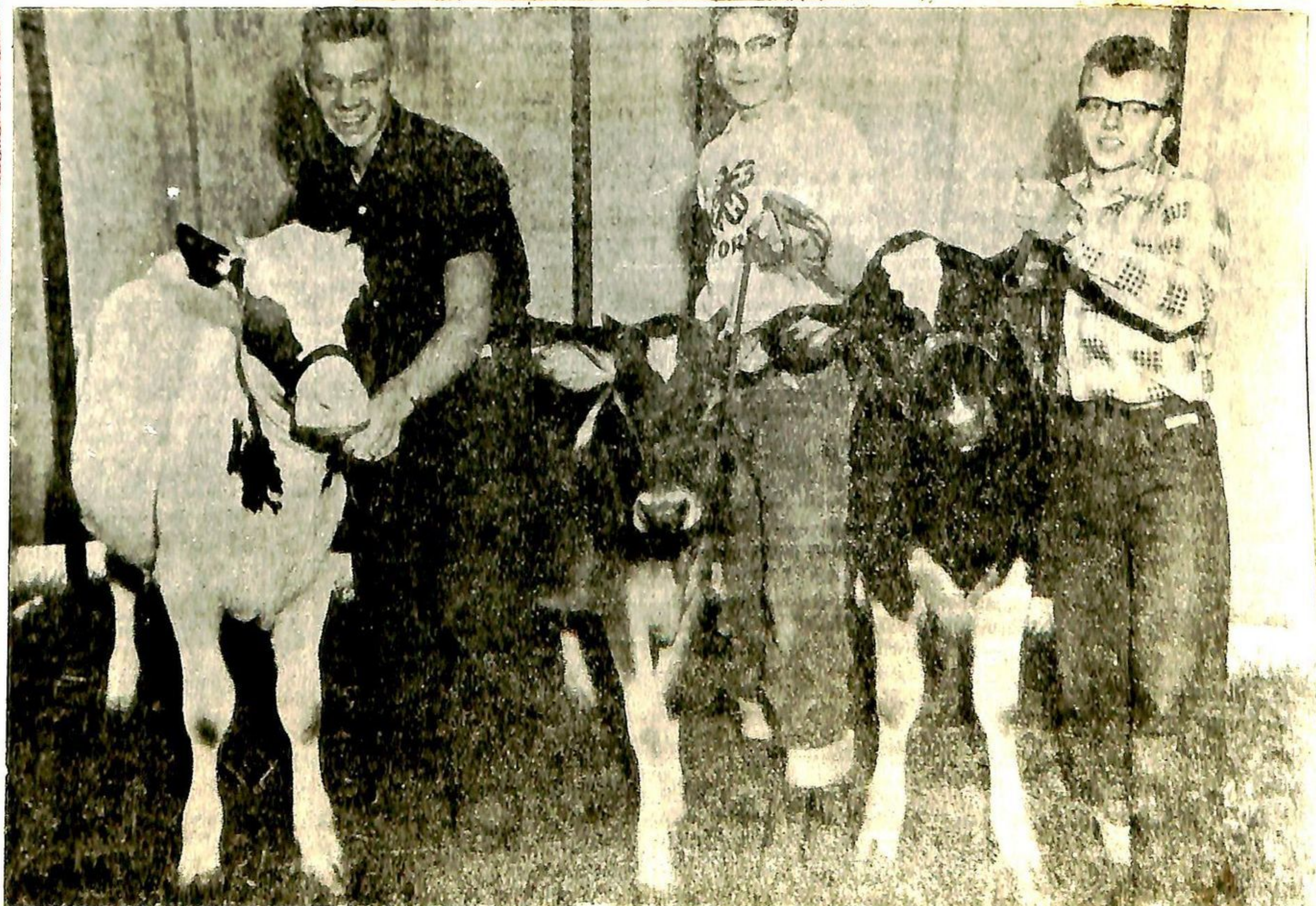
Roger Hawkins and Keith Gay of Tillsonburg awarded prizes do-
