5. 1 Minute Book of Bucke Township covering from their organization meeting in 1909 to 1914. (They disbanded in 1917 - there should be another minute book)

District books prior to 1916 were destroyed at Matheson in 1916 fire, Mrs Walter Kirstine of Matheson having them in her care as secretary at that time. Mrs Kirstine was still secretary in 1927 when district was divided into three parts and records
