

Regular Monthly Meeting

June 5th 1918

The regular monthly meeting of the Dublin Branch of the Women's Institute was held at the home of Mrs. G. McDonald on Wednesday June 5th. It was a very rainy day but eight members and two visitors were present. The meeting was opened by singing the "Opening Ode" after which the minutes of the meeting of the Executive held May 23^d were read and approved.

The formation of a War Work Committee and a Committee for Visiting the Sick was the first topic of discussion. And it was moved by Mrs. A. Stewart seconded by Mrs. C.M. Tibbs that we form a Committee of three for "Visiting the Sick." Motion carried.

Moved by Mrs. A. Smith seconded by Miss J. McLay that Mrs. A. J. Stewart be one member of that committee. Motion Carried

Moved by Mrs. A. Cooke seconded by Mrs. D. Matheson that Mrs. A. Smith be a second member of that committee. Motion carried

Moved by Mrs. A. Smith seconded by Mrs. A. Cooke that Mrs. J. McDonald be a third member of that committee. Motion carried

Moved by Mrs. A. J. Stewart seconded by Mrs. McDonald that Mrs. Ed. Tribe, Mrs. D. Ross and Mrs. D. McLay be the members of the War Work Committee. Motion carried.

Then arrangements were made for sending three representatives to the Annual District meeting at Stratton June 12th. As there were no funds in the treasury except membership fees, it was moved by Mrs. J. McDonald and seconded by Miss J. McLay that the membership fees be
