

Regular Monthly Meeting

June 11<sup>th</sup> 1919.

The first monthly meeting of the Dublin Women's Institute for the year 1919-20 was held at the home of Mrs. A. Smith on Wednesday afternoon June 11<sup>th</sup> with an unusually good attendance;
