The first owner was Octab Carron then his son Timothy Carron.

In 1919 William Bahm bought the farm and came here to live with his wife and 7 children, namely Joe, Bert, Herman, Wesley, Charlie, Alfred and one girl Lorinda.

The present home was built in 1921.

Herman and his wife, the former Edna Rutlege bought the farm in 1936. They have six children, Rhoddie, Willard, Lucille, Catherine, Lois and Robert.

In 1943 they built a new woodshed, garage and also drilled a well.

Herman in later years severed one hundred acres for his son, Rhoddie, built on this property and in a short time moved away.
