Roll Call was answered by giving items on First Aid - what to do in case of accident. These included what to do for bruises, burns, skin poisoning and swallowed poisons. (Rosin ointment, epsom salts, epsom salts and saltpetre for poisoning; cold water for bruises; bathe burns with cold tea; compress of tea leaves for sore eyes - mustard in water - salt in water - milk and lard to make vomit when poisons were swallowed.) In case of accident never move victim. When using hot compresses squeeze clothes dry with potatoe ricer.
