

The following show quantities of farm produce raised in East Missouri in 1852

Wheat - 2,000 acres, and 25,663 bushels being $12\frac{3}{4}$ bushels per acre.

Oats - 1,634 acres, and 40,178 bushels being $24\frac{1}{2}$ bushels per acre.

Pear - 155 acres, and 11,195 bushels being $41\frac{1}{2}$ bushels per acre.

Barley - 133 acres, and 2,668 bushels being 20 bushels per acre.

Rye - 1 acre, and 10 bushels.

Indian Corn - 60 acres, and 1,190 bushels being $19\frac{3}{4}$ bushels per acre.

Buckwheat - 30 acres, and 421 bushels being 14 bushels per acre.

Potatoes - 103 acres, and 4,193 bushels being 91 bushels per acre.

Sheep and Wool - 2,911 sheep, and 7,279 pounds of wool.

Horses - 475

Great Cattle - 2,552

Milk Cows - 759

Hogs - 2,571

Maple Sugar - 29,512 pounds.

Hay - 842 tons

Fuller Cloth - 1,182 yards

Flannel - 4,100 yards.
