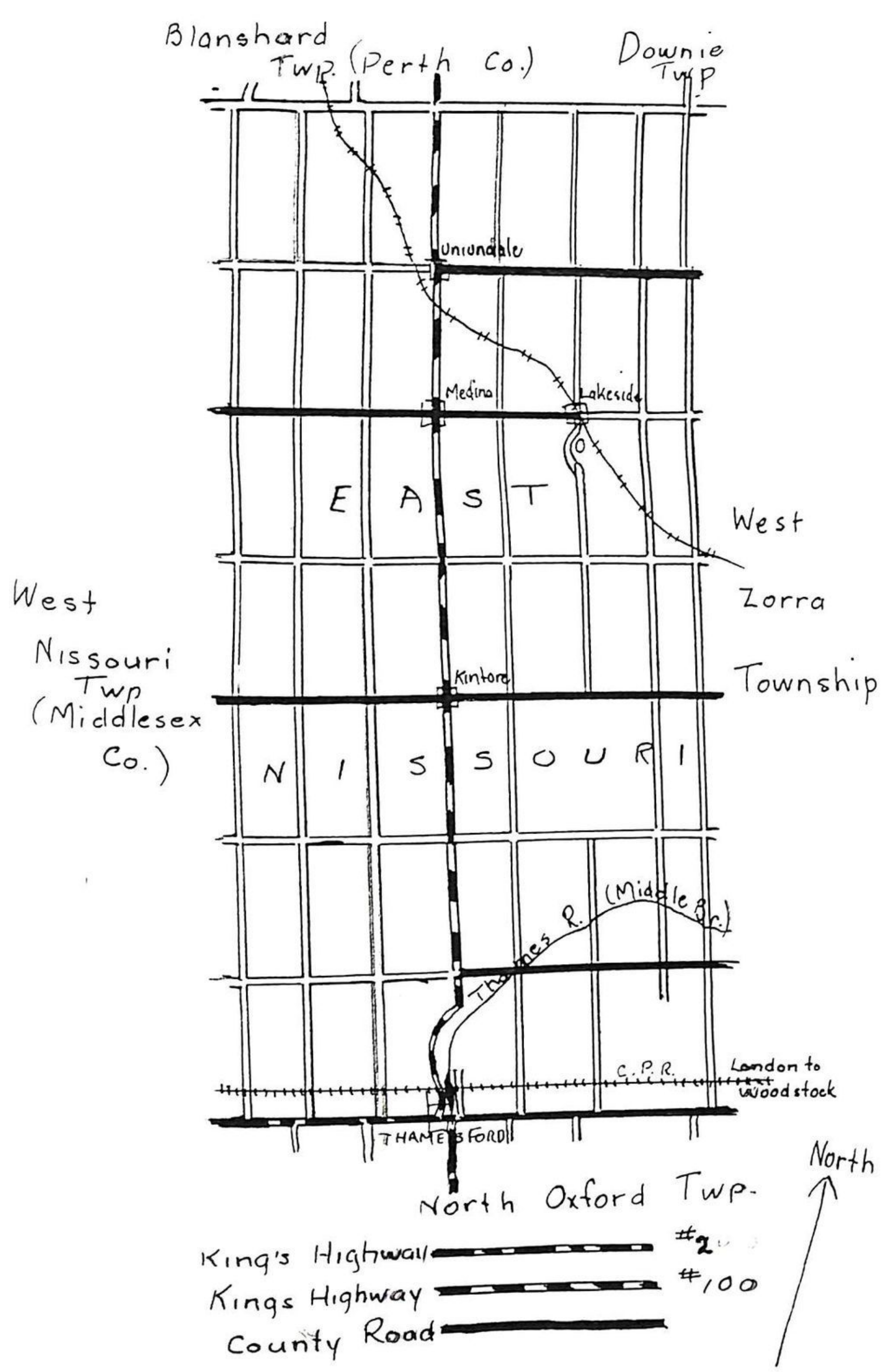


from eight to thirteen are seven-eighths of a mile wide, fourteen is half a mile wide. In each concession are 36 original lots, numbered from the south, 35 of them in the first six concessions consisting of 200 acres, the 36th of about 100 acres. In concession 14 all the lots are proportionately smaller. The narrow 36th lots and the narrow 14th concession would seem to indicate that the surrounding townships, Blanshard, Downie, (in Perth) London, (in Middlesex) and Zorra (in Oxford) were surveyed earlier than Nissouri.



Thamesford grew up on the line between North Oxford and Nissouri townships on concession 10, on lot one. Kintore is six miles by King's Highway north of Thamesford on lots 15 and 16 in concessions of 10 and 11. Four miles north of Kintore is Medina on lots 25 and 26. A mile and three quarters east of Medina is Lakeside in concessions 12 and 13. Uniondale is two miles north of Medina in lots 30 and 31.
