of having been driven over it in an ox-cart. When the township was opened up and roads surveyed the trail fell into disuse and eventually disappeared.

Beginning at a point near Thamesford, the trail headed in a north westerly direction toward Brown's Corners, on past the site of the present hamlet of Hellburn, then down a ravine to the river Thames and along this stream to St. Mary's.
