1868 - Jan. 20 - Received in order from John Adams for milk May \$40.

Dec. 31 - Rev. Mr. McDonald placed in Thamesford. 4 ministers there. Grand day. Rough waggoning.

1869 - Jan. 12 - Mr. McDonald's first sermon in Thamesford.

Mar. 13 - John Adams' cheese meeting. Nothing much done.

Mar. 18 - Miss Betsy Renton and Miss Marion their (later Mrs. Cowan) gathering money for horse and buggy for Mr. McDonald.

Mar. 20 - John Adams' second cheese meeting. They came to terms all right.

Mar. 25 - John Bell and Mary Bretinger married

Apr. 8 - Darcy McLee assassinated

Aug. 2 - six weeks without rain until yesterday.

Oct. 4 - Father (Alex. Ross Sr.) to Harrington sacrament.

Oct. 20 - Paid taxes on this farm \$17.20.

1870 - Feb. 8 - Got sewing machine. It cost \$40

Mar. 18 - Andrew Shaw's sale. (I don't know where he lived but he was married to a McFee. McFee's lived on Harry Leonard's farm before Bill Jeffrey did)

Mar. 22 - James Patterson died. (father of James & Frank)

July 4 - Sacrament at Embro.

Jan. 4, 1870 - Went to Walker's School with
